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## DEATH ROAD TOUR – BIKING

Full day

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**Duration:** 12 hours

**Pick up time:** 07:00 am

### Itinerary:

07:00 Pick up from the lodging establishments between hrs. 07:00 to 7:45 (Depending on the hotel where you are). Transfer to the foot of the Andes or Cordillera Real, exactly to the summit that is 4,700 meters above sea level. (15,420 feet) leaving the city of La Paz, we will appreciate the desert flora and fauna of the Altiplano and the snow-capped mountains of the Cordillera Real. We proceed to put on the specialized equipment for this adventure. The guides carry out the reconnaissance of our equipment to make sure that everything is well secured so that, we can later listen very carefully to the explanations of the same while having a hot snack. We begin the adventure by bicycle; the first part is asphalt with a very frigid climate until we reach the town of Unduavi (Anti-narcotics control and inspection, only by motorized transport). We take a short break with a mid-morning snack. The second stage begins on a dirt road at a height of 2,700 meters above sea level, a subtropical place. At the beginning of the Bolivian jungle exactly where the paved road ends, the most dangerous road in the world begins, known as the road of death. A dirt road and an incredible view accompany the adventure with the guides who carefully descend, passing by, rivers, waterfalls, along with the great variety of flora and fauna that the place presents us. At noon, we will take a time of a well-deserved rest of 20 minutes that accompanies a snack.

Later we reached the bridge “Yolosa”, a place with a warm climate and the end of our bicycle adventure at a height of 1,200 meters above sea level. (3,940 Feet). Then, we moved to a Rest Hotel, where after using the showers, we have lunch and enjoyed a good climate by the pool, etc. In the afternoon, return to the city of La Paz
